- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To publish information concerning the 2023 Commanding Officer's (CO) Cup Intramural Sports Program, per the reference.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. The Intramural Sports Program provides activeduty personnel stationed aboard Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) New River the opportunity to take part in a competitive unit sports program regardless of skill or experience. This program helps promote combat readiness, resiliency, esprit de corps, leadership, and teamwork. This program also helps identify and enable athletes with exceptional skills to continue on to higher levels of competition. Each league will have limited capacity; participation will be on a first come first served basis during the registration periods noted in enclosure (1).

#### 3. Action

## a. 2023 CO's Cup Intramural Sports Program Outline

- (1) The 2023 CO's Cup Program is a year-long program, beginning in January and ending in December 2023. Enclosure (1) covers the calendar of events.
- (2) The program points and division placements are provided in enclosures (2) and (3).

(3) The program will award each Division's winning unit a rotating CO's Cup to display for 10 months. The trophy may be awarded 1 December 2023, and the unit may display the trophy until 31 October 2024. On 1 November 2024, Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS), Lejeune-New River Semper Fit Sports Branch will collect the rotating trophies in preparation for the upcoming presentation.

# b. CO's Cup Intramural Sports Program Participation

- (1) Tenant commands are encouraged to endorse maximum participation in the program. The number of entries per unit may be limited.
- (2) Participation in this program is limited to activeduty personnel only.
- (3) Registration will not be accepted until a completed MCCS, Lejeune-New River Intramural Sports registration package is received by the Intramural Sports office in person or electronically.
- (4) All events are alcohol-free; no participant(s) may consume alcohol before or during the event. If a participant violates the no alcohol policy, the participant will be disqualified from the event and asked to leave.
- 4. Applicability. This Bulletin is applicable to all tenant commands, organizations, and activities aboard MCAS New River.

## Commanding Officer's Cup Points

Placement Points:
1st place = 15 pts
2nd place = 10 pts
3rd place = 5 pts

Participation Points:
1st team = 10 pts
Each additional team = 2 pts

This Bulletin is not all-encompassing for the rules and regulations that govern the MCCS, Lejeune-New River Intramural Sports Program to include the Commanding Officer's Cup. See the current edition of the MCCS, Lejeune-New River Intramural Sports Handbook which contains pertinent information regarding coaches, team formation, eligibility requirements, Code of Conduct/Ethics, sanctions, grievances, and other important information about the Intramural Sports Program.

Entries: All Commanding Officer's Cup events are co-ed. Each league will have limited capacity; participation will be on a first come, first served basis during the registration periods. The number of entries per unit may be limited depending upon availability.

<u>Placement Points</u>: Placement points are given to 1st-3rd place for winners in each division. It is possible for a unit to earn all placement points.

Entry Points: The first team registered from each unit will receive 10 entry points for participation; additional teams will receive two points per team from the same respective unit up to the 10th team. The following exceptions apply: Team league entry points will be forfeited if a team is charged a forfeit during the league or tournament for no show or behavior forfeit. League team coaches are required to inform the sports coordinator at the coaches meeting of their upcoming units' operational commitments so that the league schedule may be adjusted to accommodate a team's availability. It may be determined by the sports coordinator that a team may not be able to participate in a league or tournament due to operational commitments.

<u>Free Agent</u>: An active-duty service member may still participate in a league if their unit does not have a team entered in the league by becoming a free agent. The Intramural Sports Office reserves the right to place all free agents. Free agent player

allotments vary per sport, and placement is not guaranteed. For comprehensive policies and forms regarding free agent placement refer to the MCCS, Lejeune-New River Intramural Sports Handbook. CO's Cup Points are not awarded to the free agent's command.
