1. Situation. Emergency situations frequently arise after working hours which require the services of a Chaplain.

2. Cancellation. ASO 1730.5L.

3. <u>Mission</u>. To set forth procedures for Chaplain coverage of Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) New River, Marine Aircraft Group 26 (MAG-26), MAG-29, and all other tenant commands, per the reference and enclosure.

4. <u>Execution</u>. To eliminate unnecessary delay in obtaining Chaplain services, the Command Duty Officer (CDO) and Group Duty Officers (GDOs) will utilize the enclosure to contact the appropriate Chaplains for emergencies after hours.

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) <u>Commander's Intent</u>. To ensure the provision of pastoral care for all personnel in the event of an emergency.

(2) <u>Concept of Operations.</u> Coordination between the CDO and GDOs with the appropriate Chaplain is vitally important. This communication will ensure pastoral care is provided in a timely and sufficient manner when an emergency situation arises.

b. Tasks

(1) MCAS New River Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron Personnel. If in need of after-hours Chaplain services, call the Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCB CAMLEJ)

(3) <u>MAG-26 Personnel</u>. If in need of Chaplain services, call the MAG-26 Chaplain's office at (910) 449-7180 or the MAG-26 GDO at (910) 449-6126. The MAG-26 Command Chaplain can also be contacted at (910) 545-7883.

(4) MAG-29 Personnel. If in need of Chaplain services, call the MAG-29 Chaplain's office at (910) 449-6866 or the MAG-29 GDO at (910) 449-6345. The MAG-29 Command Chaplain can also be contacted at (910) 381-6135.

5. <u>Administration and Logistics</u>. Command Base Chaplain, MAG-26 Chaplain, and MAG-29 Chaplain will provide the MCB CAMLEJ CDO with their office number, duty cell phone number, and CDO and GDO phone numbers for contact.

6. Command and Signal

a. <u>Command</u>. The Commanding Officers of Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, MAG-26, and MAG-29 concur with this Order insofar as it pertains to members of their commands.

DUTY CHAPLAIN CONTACT PROCEDURES

1. <u>Duty Chaplain Contact Procedures</u>. This enclosure is to be used by the Command Duty Officer (CDO) for contacting the appropriate Chaplain and ensuring immediate Chaplain coverage is available.

a. <u>During Normal Working Hours</u>. The appropriate Chaplain for each command can be reached using the following numbers. The normal working hours are 0730-1630, Monday through Friday.
